

PERMANENT ANGLING LICENSE

To qualify for a permanent angling license you must provide documentation that you meet the eligibility for one of the following statutes:

Statute **97A.441 Subd.4**. A permanent angling license will be issued, without a fee, to a resident 16 years of age and older who is developmentally disabled upon furnishing satisfactory evidence of the disability.

A doctor's statement/diagnosis of the applicant's disability must accompany this application.

Statute **97A.441 Subd 5**. A permanent angling license will be issued, without a fee, to a resident who is a veteran and has a 100 % service connected disability as defined by the United States Veterans Administration upon furnishing satisfactory evidence.

Documentation from the Veterans Administration stating a 100% service connected disability must accompany this application.
